There are concerns about the removal of the trees on the boundary. They favour suitable native replacements.
There are Highway concerns - With increased traffic on the small back-road there is road safety and the lack of street lighting have been highlighted.
Also concerns the road lies just outside the village speed limit boundary - inclusion would allow road-safety concerns to be allayed as traffic should be travelling slower than the national average which currently applies. Proposed Cllr Laity, seconded*

 CC – CC has given full support for the Spaceport proposal at Newquay airport; The Allocations development plan has been adopted; The Budget is due to be confirmed by cabinet in January and is set to be a 2% rise of council tax plus a 2% social care rise.
