144/19 **TYLLER TEG REFURBISHMENT**

Since the last parish council meeting there have been two site meetings, and a final decision made about the refurbishment plan and equipment order for the area.
The order has been accepted, and it is anticipated work will begin around 22nd July.

Now need to set up a working party to take out and remove the old equipment which are due to be replaced. –Cllr Milnes, Cllr Mackenzie, Cllr Matthews, Cllr Laity and Phil Michell, and anyone else available on dates to be decided.

There followed discussions about fencing, as this was to be replaced as the play equipment order had been a slightly reduced price than the original set budget.

Agreed metal galvanised fencing would be preferable – not powder coated. Cllr Mackenzie Cllr Mackenzie
agreed to get suitable quotes and bring to next meeting. Discussion about fitting and supplying –need to be careful as site is tricky and levels important.

Path accessing site also needs work – agreed to look at after the rest of work completed and discuss further. Benches also suggested – investigate again after other work completed.
